Tension Elis Valente

Dance, installation · Spain Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> From the investigation of the materiality of elastic bands, *Tension* stages our own vulnerability. Facing a large latex wall, the artist attempts to make her way through acrobatics, aerial work and dance. She reveals an intimate space of discomfort where pleasure turns to pain and pain to aggression. But how much pain can one take?



IGNIS Collectif Sismique Nicolas Fraiseau Pyrotechnics, clown · France Creation 2025 To know more

IGNIS presents a new aesthetic of fire, one that is no longer grandiose and spectacular, but minuscule and metaphorical. This solo performance explores the contrasts caused by flames. This fiery aesthetic draws on the poetics of archaism, nostalgia and ritual ceremonies to create an intimate bond with the audience.



KRAQUEMENT Lucia Heege Torres

Contortion, trapeze · France Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> Based on various stories of exile, *KRAQUEMENT* invites the audience on a sensorial and emotional journey. Through a multidisciplinary performance, using swinging trapeze, live music, paint, in a landscape of kraft paper and coal, two performers express the chaos, as well as the resilience, will and hope these stories have inspired in them.



AVoid Marina Cherry

Contortion · Sweden Creation 2024 <u>To know more</u> AVoid was born out of a fascination with solitude. It explores the mysteries of existence.. In an unidentified space, an unusual body oscillates between order and chaos, while chasing its fantasies, fears and neuroses. A journey through the mutations of identity, remind us of the fragility of the human condition.



MISS SBarbie – a punk collective history about our messy bodies Morgana Morandi

Aerial hoop, clown · Italy Creation 2025 To know more Once upon a time dolls allowed little girls to imagine all sorts of worlds. Today there's Morgana and her 137 Barbies, playmates of imagination and adventure. A universe that brings back to life long-forgotten parts of ourselves. An invitation to reclaim ownership over our bodies.



Là où la nuit n'est pas si loin puisque le jour s'en va déjà

Noa Aubry German wheel · France Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> Inspired by the movement of waves, Là où la nuit n'est pas si loin puisque le jour s'en va déjà explores time and the traces it leaves behind. Using the German wheel to create a slow, repetitive, and even transcendent movement, Noa Aubry invites the audience to dive into the ocean.

Fragmentos

La Vispera Vinka Delgado Diego Hernando Puppet, chinese pole · Spain Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> Fragmentos divides the body to better understand it. The artists take an intimate and poetic approach to explore the distortion and disintegration of the body. Masks, puppetry, and light research open a discussion on pain and how it can be relieved through fragmentation. When suffering becomes too intense, the mind splits.



Le bruit des pierres

Maison Courbe Nina Harper, Domitille Martin, Ricardo Cabral Acrodance, aerial · France Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> What can we learn from stones? In this hybrid creation, the stones, crystals, and rocks are transformed into suspended props and real stage partners. While questioning the relationship between human and their environment, the performers evolve and create a choreography of suspension, imbalance, and collapse.



Splash

Jam.Shenanigans Henri Kangas, Batist Van Baekel Juggling · Belgium Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> Two characters oppressed by the outside world resort to their survival mechanism: juggling. In the heart of this imaginary universe, a swimming pool of 25,000 balls turns juggling into something as natural as walking, the last becoming strangely difficult. From humour to absurdity, it's an unlikely attempt to reach the juggling paradise.



Saucisson

Taigi Cirkas Elena Kosovec, Izabele Kuzelyte Aerial acrobatics · Lithuania Creation 2025 To know more What happens when the artist loses control? When an object becomes uncontrollable, absurd, or even reveals a absent feeling? *Saucisson* is about the desacralisation of the props and the circus body. A multidisciplinary creation that blends visual art, aerial acrobatics, and opera, freely inspired by surrealism and theatre of the absurd.



Traces Hristina Sormaz

Rope · Serbia Creation 2025 To know more How can humans and nature coexist? *Traces* depicts a shared ecosystem where the performer, space and matter influence each other. The artist uses clay and her body to create a landscape depicting conflict, destruction, and harmony. It's a call for awareness of the human impact on the environment.

Aerial straps · France Creation 2025 <u>To know more</u> Three circus performers, united together by straps, explore the expression of their relationship through this common bond. Acrobats and objects become one. How can intimacy reveal itself in a group? How can an individual be part of a whole? *QUIMERA* invites the audience on a journey from the individual to the collective.
